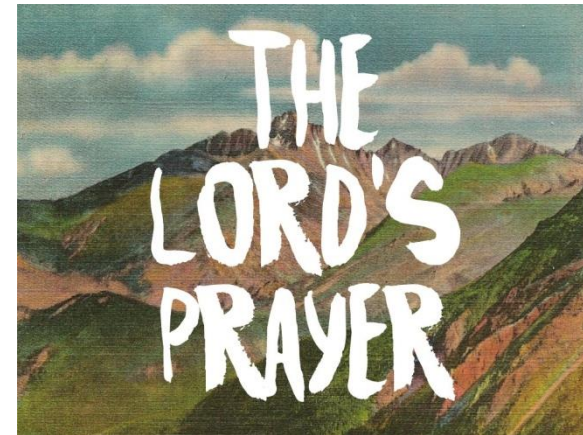

The Prayer of Connection: Our Father in Heaven: The first move in prayer is knowing whom we’re talking to.
