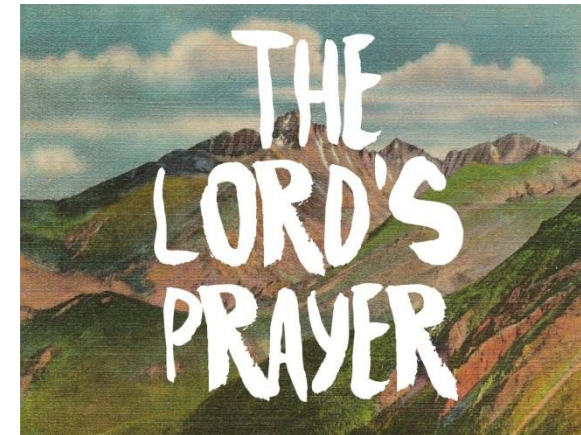

### Highlights of Full Council Meeting held February 28/17

Following devotions and prayer, Chairman Stewart VanSchepen welcomed everyone present. Absent with notice: Brs. Chad Pasma, Ralph Haverkamp, John Butler, Raymond Bentum, Sisters Chris Voskamp and Pam Gray. Absent: Br. Jonathan Klingenberg

A letter was received from Dave Sanders asking to be relieved from his duties as Elder as he works many afternoon/evening shifts. It was approved to acquiesce to his request. Sharon will email his ward and a note will be in the bulletin. There will be 3 elders elected this spring of which one will take on a 2 year term.

Various reports were received from the Ministry Coordinator, Business Committee, Deacons, Fellowship and Treasurer. Arising from these reports.

-All but 2 of the catechism questionnaires have been received back. They will be looked over and at the next elders meeting they will be discussing them and coming up with a plan.

-There were a number of people interested in helping with a refugee family, but not enough people to form a team or someone that wanted to take leadership. The Deacons have directed those interested to Kelly Byers who is working with a sponsorship family. She had been in contact with Pam Gray and was looking for help with the family and also financially. The monies that have been collected for help with a refugee family have been sent to her. A report will be given in the near future as to how the family is progressing in the community.

-Administrative Council has been looking at the budget numbers discussing how we can bring our budget to a more comfortable level. One of the ways is to submit a mortgage application to extend our amortization term to 13 years from the current 6 years to lower our monthly payments. This was supported and approved by Full Council.

-A revised budget will be brought to the congregation at our Spring Congregational meeting for approval.

We also discussed the comparison giving from 2015 to 2016. It was noted that those who do not give, it is a habit. How do we encourage people to give? Encouragement and education is the key.

Pastor Daryl joined us following his Pastor's Class and we moved into a time of Censura Morum led by Pastor Daryl after which this portion of the evening was closed with prayer.

Executive Session took place to discuss the nominations. Sharon will put the letters together for the Ward Elders and they will be in the mailboxes for this Sunday. Please make your visits before the end of March.
