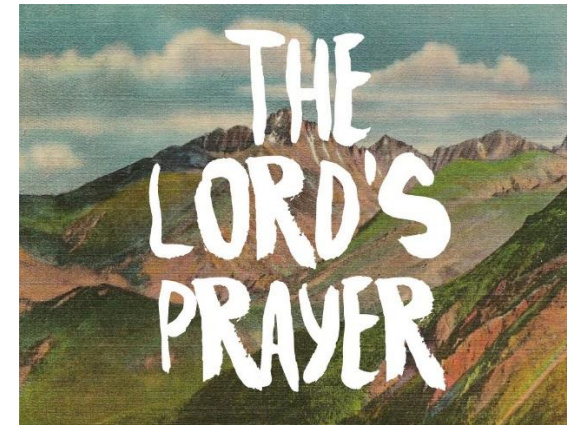

**LENTEN SERIES: The Prayer of Trust: “Give Us This Day...”**

The first we-focused request of the prayer is also called the hinge, or centre of the prayer. That makes sense, since prayer, and the whole Christian life, can be summarized by the word bread. Jesus teaches His followers that life is lived one day at a time, not asking for riches, but bread, and just enough for the day. This could be called “the prayer of the open hand”. We do not take from God but simply receive from Him what we are given. Jesus’ parables and sayings spoken after the prayer in Luke have significant impact for us in this message, as Jesus goes on to teach that prayer has lots to do with asking for bread, and even more to do with trusting that it will be given.
